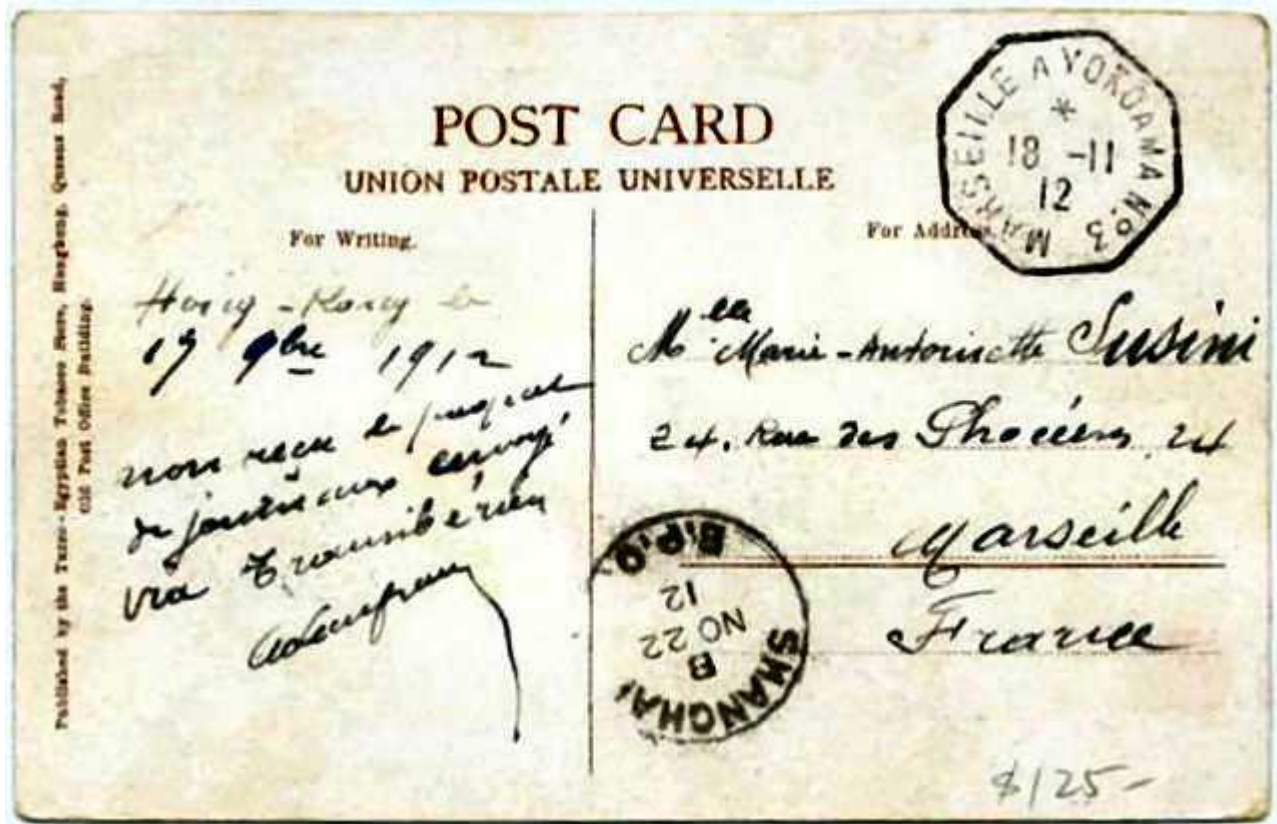

Adhesive of Hong Kong - 1882-96 issue (Queen Victoria - Watermark crown CA) - SG 35 - 5c. pale blue - Cancellation by French mail boat marking "Corr.D.Arm./Lig.N P.Fr.N°2" - In black - Webb type "Class A (iv)" - Salles 1.946/2 - Dated : 21 april 1885 - Ship's name : "Iraouaddy" - Due to the military operations by the Courbet's Squadron against Formosa, Pescadores Islands and Foochow, the terminal for the "Ligne N" was temporary transferred to Hong Kong.
Shipping route : Departure from Marseilles (15 february 1885) - Return journey from Hong Kong (21 april 1885), via Saigon (24 april), arrival in Marseilles (24 may 1885).

IRAOUADDY, 2 000 tonneaux, 2 900 CV - 1^{er} départ : 30 mars 1873.
Effectue 31 voyages entre 1873 et 1890.

Adhesive of Hong Kong - 1882-96 issue (Queen Victoria - Watermark crown CA) - SG 35a - 5c. blue - Cancellation by French mail boat marking "Corr.D Arm. / Lig.N Paq.Fr. N° 8" - In small double-circle - In black - Webb type N - Salles 1.949/8 - Dated : October 1884 - Ship's name : "Djemnah" - Due to the military operations of the "Courbet's Squadron" against "Black flags" in Formosa, Pescadores Islands and Foochow, the terminal for the "Ligne N" was temporary transferred to Hong Kong . Shipping route : Departure from Marseilles (3 august 1884) - Return journey from Hong Kong (2 october), via Saigon (6 october) and arrival in Marseilles (5 november 1884).

DJEMNAH, 2.400 tonneaux, 2.900 CV. 1^{er} départ : 11 avril 1875.
Effectue 48 voyages entre 1875 et 1897.
